individuals, groups and families of Deaf/deafblind Persons are strongly recommended.

Posters (size: +1500mm x 1000mm) must be in place on 21 November 2022 at 14:00 and will

be displayed from 22-24 November. For poster presentations please send a 200-word summary

as an e-mail attachment.

Abstracts of papers and summaries of posters must be received by 15 August 2022. Send to

conference@deafnet.org. A full text of the presentation of an author whose abstract was

accepted should reach the scientific committee at conference@deafnet.org before Wednesday

30 August 2022.

**Abstract and summary selection** 

The scientific committee will evaluate each submission according to the theme and the

Conference overall objectives. Workshop papers will be selected on the relevance to the theme.

The presentation must be Deaf friendly. The outcome of selection and notification of

acceptance will be sent by 15 September 2022.

if they wish to withdraw their presentation.
